### Artistic Rep Report – January 24, 2023

- The end of year awards and skate night on 17 December was successful with some of our development skaters putting on a small show with the help of their trainee coaches. Given the short time until League 1 and the late timing of Novice championships, other skaters were busy working on their own routines with their coaches and Sue was away at worlds for much of the lead up.
- The Kingsway open day also on 17 December was a big success with a lot of interest shown in roller skating. Amadee, Larree, Emma G and Matthew all attended to help and give demonstrations.
- The Gawaine Davis skate camp from 7-9 January in Bunbury was a huge success for all involved and has sparked a lot of enthusiasm and creativity. 2 development level skaters (Rose and Julia), 2 Preliminary grade skaters (Emma and Charlotte), 1 Juvenile (Matthew) and 2 Masters skaters (Helen and Rachael) and Larree attended. Charlie V (not a current member but skating with us) also attended. The subsidy for the 8 relevant skaters has been paid.
- During the skate camp, Ozzy booked a 2 hour session at the South West Sports Centre for skaters to try out the floor. This was much appreciated and positive feedback was received with skaters looking forward to skating on the high quality floor at States and Nationals.
- Seminar 1 was held in the afternoon of Sunday 22 January to assist with judge and technical/official training. Andrew demonstrated and presented some of the new dances. A mock competition of some events for training were then held, followed by a Q&A for officials.
- League 1 is taking place the weekend of 28-29 January (earlier than usual) in line with version 3 of the artistic skating calendar.) Dance and Free skate events will be held at Kingsway on the Saturday and Figures at Morley on the Sunday.
- Nominations for League 2 will close not long after the League 1 competition as League 2 is scheduled for 11-12 March.
- The date of Sunday March 26 has been set for the development competition to be hosted at Morley RollerDrome. This has been added to the artistic skating calendar.
- Competitive artistic skater membership is coming in successfully through Revolutionize with most of last year's competitive members now registered and a

few new ones added. I am working on chasing up a few who still need to register if they wish to compete in League 2 or beyond.
