Artistic Rep Report - 25 March, 2024

- League 2 was held on 24 and 25 February and ran smoothly. Some skaters who are working towards their judging commissions were also able to judge on the mentoring table. There were three withdrawals, one affecting a quartet.
- Nominations for League 3 closed on March 15 with 22 skaters nominating. The figures draw has been released and the draft program is due out soon. League 3 will take place 13 and 14 April. Nominations for States are due on April 15.
- SIA certificates are starting to come in from skaters. A reminder will be sent out in April.
- Larree Bond was invited to be an official at the latest League in Victoria. She was there the weekend of 16-17 March. Amadee Bond travelled with her and competed in the League.
- Three skaters (Elecia, Taysha and Matthew) assisted Ozzy at Kingsway for their open day on 16 March. They represented artistic skating, gave demonstrations and helped visitors skate.
- Bunbury Development Competition is on Saturday 6 April. Information has been circulated to members and some development skaters are planning to participate.
- A monthly freeskating workshop with Rebecca is starting up. The first one is on Saturday 6 April and will run from 4pm until 6.30pm. As there was no workshop in March an extra one for April is planned on 20 April instead. These will be open to all skaters from all clubs with a reduced participation cost for skaters who pay rink fees. The afternoon workshops will start with basic skills and progress up to more advanced skills by the end. There will also be off skate skills offered.
- The ideas of workshops (just for Morley skaters) around dance are also being considered but are not as advanced at this point.
- The Oceania artistic team announcement has been made and Brianna Hasson, Willow Burr, Mary Rutherford, Matthew Williams and Amadee Bond (pending viewing) have been selected. Norman
