Artistic Rep Report – 30 September, 2024

- The SkateWA AGM was held on Sunday 15 September. Sally Vinar stepped down from the role of VP/Chair and Norman O'Rourke was voted in as the new VP for a 2 year term. There were no other changes.
- There is a draft 2024/5 skate calendar in the process of being released, however dates for Oceania and State Championships are still being confirmed. International requirements have been released but still waiting on confirmation of National requirements.
- The proficiency tests which were run on 31 August went smoothly with some figures proficiencies at least planned later in the year. The novice championships were small but based on the number of development skaters participating in the development championships this year, next year's novice championships could well be much bigger. The atmosphere on the day was really positive.
- The freeskating workshops with Rebecca continue to be well attended. Last one was 7 September with the next one on 5 October.
- The coaches have started a series of development coach workshops for those involved in the accreditation process to build up coaching skills.
- From October 25 to 27 there will be a dance skate camp featuring Alessandra Sain with Mercedes Carrascosa hosted by Cobras/SkateWA at Rollerzone and Midvale, which should be a really exciting opportunity for skaters.
- Finally as another Panthers year draws to a close, we are looking forward to the AGM and Club Awards evening on 3 November where we get to recognise the efforts of skaters in our club.
